NOTICE OF THE PREPARATION OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE DRAFT DUBLIN CITY DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2011-2017

Notice is hereby given that the Members of Dublin City Council, having considered the Draft Dublin City Development Plan and the Manager's Report thereon in accordance with Section 12 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended) have resolved that the Draft Development Plan be amended. The proposed amendments constitute a material alteration of the Draft Dublin City Development Plan 2011-2017.

The proposed amendments are accompanied by an Environmental Report on the likely significant effects on the environment of implementing the proposed amendments, prepared in accordance with the Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) Regulations 2004 and an Appropriate Assessment, pursuant to Article 6 of the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC.

A copy of the Proposed Amendments, the Environmental Report on the likely significant effects on the environment of implementing the proposed amendments and the Appropriate Assessment will be on public display at the locations listed hereunder from Wednesday, 18th August, 2010 to Wednesday, 15th September, 2010 inclusive.

Observations or submissions regarding the Proposed Amendments and/or Environmental Report and/or Appropriate Assessment of implementing the proposed amendments are invited from members of the public and other interested parties.
